

Stocky Alternatives — Comparison

As of 2026-07-31 | Compiled from each vendor's public website and Shopify App Store listing. Prices and features change, so **please verify against the current pages when you actually make a decision**. Source URLs and the date each was checked are in the footnotes.

Stocky — the inventory app bundled with Shopify POS Pro — **reaches end of support on 31 August 2026**. This table lines up the main migration candidates. It also includes **Shopify's own native purchasing features (built into the admin, no extra cost)**, since that is the default destination for many stores.

Read this before comparing. UreyukiBox is built for stores selling in Japan. Its screens and purchase-order PDFs follow the Shopify admin language, so an English admin gets an English interface — but **notification emails, Slack and LINE messages remain Japanese only, and support is provided in Japanese**. Several rows below score UreyukiBox highly precisely because of Japan-specific requirements (consumption tax categories, qualified-invoice numbers, fixed yen pricing). If your store has no Japanese operation, those advantages will not apply to you. We would rather you knew that now.

Where UreyukiBox genuinely fits — and where it does not

It fits when you sell in Japan.

1. **The price is a fixed amount in yen.** Most competing apps bill in USD, so the yen amount a Japanese store actually pays moves every month with the exchange rate. UreyukiBox charges a fixed yen amount (¥0–¥12,800) through Shopify's in-app billing, with no FX movement. (The Shopify App Store listing shows an approximate USD figure automatically — that is a platform behaviour.)
2. **Qualified-invoice purchase orders are standard.** 8%/10% consumption tax categories and the registration number are printed, so the PO is usable as-is in Japanese trade practice.
3. **Stocky migration is automatic and guaranteed.** Suppliers, purchase orders, stock adjustments and tax categories are imported with their relationships intact through a four-step wizard. If we cannot complete it, we refund the following billing month. Stores that never used Stocky skip this entirely — install, sync, and start.

It does not fit if you have no Japanese operation. The screens work in English, but the advantages that put UreyukiBox at the top of several rows above are Japan-specific — consumption-tax categories, qualified-invoice numbers, fixed yen pricing — and none of them help a store selling elsewhere. Notifications and support are Japanese only. If that is your situation, Fabrikatör and Inventory Planner are the more sensible comparisons on this table.
