

UreyukiBox — inventory and purchasing for Shopify stores selling in Japan

Stocky, Shopify's own inventory and purchasing app, reaches end of life on 31

August 2026. UreyukiBox was built as the destination for Japanese stores that need to move their supplier records, purchase orders and stock adjustments somewhere. It has been **live on the Shopify App Store since 30 July 2026** (full launch mid-August 2026).

For a store selling in Japan, UreyukiBox is a **direct successor to Stocky**: it covers the purchasing workflow, then adds Japanese-language operation, qualified-invoice compliance, and deeper forecasting and inventory analysis. The **order-to-receipt loop runs entirely inside the app**, writing stock back to the same native Shopify ledger Stocky used. Stock adjustments, stocktakes, transfers between locations and barcode scanning are all supported.

A note on language. The interface follows your Shopify admin language: if your admin is set to English, UreyukiBox's screens, its purchase-order PDFs and its barcode labels are in English. **Notification emails, Slack and LINE messages are still Japanese only**, as are a few server-generated CSV headers, and **support is provided in Japanese**. The product is built for stores selling in Japan — several of its strengths (consumption-tax categories, qualified-invoice numbers, fixed yen pricing) only matter if you have a Japanese operation.

Core capabilities

Capability	What it does
Reorder reminders	Demand forecasting from sales velocity, with safety stock and seasonality (Japanese mid-year and year-end gift seasons, public holidays), plus intermittent demand and first-lot sizing for new products. The arithmetic behind it — replenishment target – on hand – incoming — is visible on screen
Qualified-invoice purchase orders	Drafts a PO per supplier automatically. Edit quantity, unit price and tax category (reduced 8% / standard 10%), then export to PDF or CSV, or email it to the supplier. Prints the qualified-invoice registration number (T + 13 digits) and your own business details

Capability	What it does
Receiving and PO status	"Mark as ordered" confirms a PO and deducts the incoming quantity from the next suggestion. Record receipts including partial deliveries, with barcode scanning
Warehouse operations	Stock adjustments with reason codes, stocktakes, transfers between locations, barcode label printing, and multiple suppliers per SKU
Warehouse operations	Stock adjustments with reason codes, stocktakes (barcode scanning or a bulk CSV of counted quantities), transfers between locations (Business), barcode label printing
Landed cost	Allocate freight, duties and other charges across the lines of a purchase order to get a landed unit cost (Pro and above). Allocate by value or by quantity. Never written back to the product cost
Profit and supplier reports	Margin by product, plus order volume, average lead time and on-time rate by supplier, over a date range (Pro and above). Lines excluded for a missing cost or unsynced revenue are always reported as a count
Notifications	Email / Slack / LINE (Slack and LINE on Pro; LINE once per day). Message bodies are Japanese only
Interface language	Japanese and English — follows your Shopify admin language automatically. Purchase-order PDFs and barcode labels are localised too. Notifications and support remain Japanese
Stocky migration (optional)	Imports suppliers, purchase orders, stock adjustments and tax categories in four steps, with their relationships intact — available from the Free plan. Once the Stocky API is gone, reorder points, lead times and stocktake history can be imported from CSV . Stores that never used Stocky skip this and start straight away

Safety — stock changes only when you act

Syncing, forecasting and drafting purchase orders **read** your Shopify data and nothing more. Your Shopify stock changes only when **you** act in the app — recording a receipt, recording a stock adjustment, confirming a stocktake, or recording a transfer between locations. Nothing is written automatically. By design, installing the app cannot leave your stock out of step.

Migration and refund guarantee

If a migration from Stocky cannot be completed for reasons on our side, we **refund the full subscription fee for the billing month immediately following the migration.**

The Free plan already covers manual qualified-invoice purchase orders, inventory visibility and the full Stocky migration. Automatic order-quantity calculation, reorder-point management, auto-drafting from the forecast and the daily email alert start at Starter; Slack and LINE alerts at Pro.

Prices are fixed amounts in Japanese yen. **Stores that pay Shopify in Japanese yen are billed that yen amount, with no FX movement and no conversion fee. Stores that pay Shopify in another currency are billed the corresponding amount in that currency.**

The Shopify App Store listing shows an approximate USD figure automatically — a platform behaviour, not a separate price. (Pricing as of 2026-07-31.)

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
